- Coaches, administrators, and out-going seniors will administer tryouts.
- No parents, family members, or friends are permitted inside the building or gyms during tryouts
- The formal tryouts are judged by FMHS cheer coaches.

Announcement of New Squads:

Results will be posted at 12:30 pm on March 7 to jaguarcheer.org and Instagram @fmhscheer.

Squad members will be posted by tryout number.

Names will be posted 1 week after tryouts.

Final roster decisions will be determined by squad coaches, head coach, and FMHS admin.

Tryout Clinic Process:

<u>Friday:</u> Cheer and Dance will be posted to the tryout Band. Please learn as much of the material as you can before the clinic on Monday. Cheer candidates will benefit more with time reviewing and cleaning during the clinic.

Monday - Tuesday: Form stunt groups, divide into groups to rotate stations. Stations include: jumps, motions, spirit/cheer, dance, and stunt.

Wednesday: Stunt and Jump evaluations, final review of material

Thursday: Formal Tryouts

Coaches reserve the right to conference with tryout candidates on performance, skill concerns, and behavior.

Tryout Day:

- 1. Rally in the door entering the gym
- 2. Running tumbling individually
- 3. Rally to performance mat
- 4. Standing Tumbling individually
- 5. Cheer individually
- Varsity: Rally Routine and Dance Non-Varsity: Dance
- 7. Rally out exiting the gym

Varsity:

- Team may consists of seniors, juniors, and sophomores
- There is not a definite number for varsity, but usually consists between 18-25 members.

JV:

- Team may consist of juniors, sophomores, and freshmen, if needed.
- Juniors must sign a form indicating their acknowledgement and acceptance of placement. If they do not qualify for Varsity, and indicate on the form they do not want to be on JV, they will not be accepted on any team.
- There is not a definite number for JV, but usually consists between 10-15 members.

Freshman:

- Team may only consist of freshmen.
- There is not a definite number for Freshman, but usually consists between 10-15 members.

Purpose of being a FMHS Cheerleader:

Being a cheerleader is an honor and a privilege. Those selected to be members of the Flower Mound High School Cheer Program are expected to abide by and uphold all school rules and policies. In addition, cheerleaders are to adhere to the LISD Cheerleader handbook. Our purpose is to build school spirit and bring positivity and encouragement to the school, all sports programs, activities, and in the community. We strive to be selfless, kind, hardworking, and boost overall FMHS morale.

Estimated Costs:

New incoming Cheerleader on JV or Freshmen: \$1700

Returning JV Cheerleader: \$1300 New Varsity Cheerleader: \$1800

New To Program Varsity Cheerleader: \$2200

Returning Varsity Cheerleader: \$1400

These amounts are only an approximate amount and are subject to change after final orders, bookings, and fittings. New program uniforms may be purchased for the 2025 year and will require an additional uniform rental fee.

There will be extra costs throughout the year that will need to be purchased individually.

- 6. I understand that I am expected to participate in all community service and fundraising activities set by the coaches.
- 7. I have reviewed the Spring/Summer Schedule provided and confirm that I CAN attend ALL mandatory events and summer cheerleading camp.
- 8. I understand that missing a mandatory event or summer cheerleading camp can/will result in removal from the squad.
- 9. I understand that Flower Mound Cheer comes before any other extra-curricular activity and I must work around my Flower Mound Cheerleading schedule when participating in any outside activity.
- 10. I understand that my coach expects me to maintain the skills and spirit performed at tryouts throughout the course of the season.
- 11. I understand that my coach has the right to bench a cheerleader during a game or event for not meeting communicated expectations during a performance. This includes skills, spirit, behavior, etc.
- 12. I understand that if I am out of proper uniform at a game or event, my coach has the right to not allow me to participate.
- 13. I understand that coaches and administrators have the right to make decisions on my behalf when it comes to discipline or removal from the program, when it deems necessary.
- 14. I understand that all tryout decisions and rosters are FINAL. Any and all questions and concerns will be addressed with the coach directly.
- 15. I have read the handbook and will commit to adhering to all parts of it throughout my season as an FMHS Cheerleader.

FMHS Cheerleading PARENT Tryout Agreement

Cheerleading is a commitment and takes up a great amount of time and dedication on the part of the parents. Prior to tryouts, read and consider the following information before allowing your daughter/son to try out for the FMHS Cheerleading Program. Parent/guardian commitment and involvement are vital to the success of each cheerleader and the cheerleading team. If your daughter/son is selected, the following guidelines will be expected from the parents:

- 1. Parents will encourage their athletes to follow and abide by the rules set forth by the handbook, coaches, and administrators.
- 2. Parents will attend the monthly booster club meetings. Your attendance is vital.
- 3. Parents will pay all dues on time.
- 4. Parents will refrain from using cheerleading as a punishment for your athlete. This does not just punish one cheerleader, but the entire squad.
- 5. Parents will oversee the time management of your cheerleader (ex: practice and game schedules, community service, team building, sign paintings, etc.)
- 6. Parents will provide punctual transportation if needed.
- 7. Parents will direct concerns about your cheerleader on an individual basis directly to the appropriate coach, first. (Freshman will contact the freshman coach, and so on)
- 8. Parents will follow the LISD Chain of Command. (See FMHS Campus Cheerleading Guidelines and Expectations Handbook).
- 9. Parents will strive to speak positively to other parents, community members, athletes, etc,. about the team, program, coaches, and other athletes involved in the FMHS
- Cheerleading Program. This is the only way to maintain a strong program.
- 10. Parents will provide the encouragement your cheerleader needs in his/her pursuit of excellence.
- 11. Parents need to schedule all appointments so as to avoid the cheerleader missing cheer class, practices or events as this impacts the entire squad.
- 12. Parents will check emails and calendars for updates.
- 13. Parents will assist with volunteer and fundraising activities.
- 14. Parents will follow all forms of proper communication when addressing/speaking with the coach. (See FMHS Campus Cheerleading Guidelines and Expectations Handbook).
- 15. Parents will understand and support that the coaches are responsible for instructing the practices and performances, creating and enforcing cheerleading rules and consequences, and making decisions for the team as a whole. Please respect decisions made by the coach and contact them directly with any questions and/or concerns.

Please understand that unforeseen circumstances do occur; interim changes may be made at the discretion of the coaches and administrators. All decisions made by the coaches and/or administration are final. Thank you for all of your support.
