President's Comments Julie M.

- 2023 – 2024 Booster Board: Nominations are currently being accepted for the position of 2nd VP. This board member oversees the Sponsorship committee. Please contact Julie M. if you are interested in the 2nd VP position.
- Julie M. proposed the following changes to the Jaguar Spirit, Inc. Bylaws:
 1. Booster Club members of graduating seniors, who are in good standing, may remain members of the Booster Club and Board for the purpose of Board position turnover after their senior cheerleaders have left the team/class. (Per school policy, all senior cheerleaders are required to transfer out of the cheer class after the spring tryouts, so they must enroll in another class for the last 9 weeks of school.) Turnover of the Board positions should be completed in April after the new Booster Board has been voted in.
 2. The position of Assistant Treasurer will be added to the Booster Board to assist the Treasurer with their responsibilities. The Assistant Treasurer position will also be covered by the Jaguar Spirit, Inc. insurance policy.
- The two proposed changes to the Board Bylaws were voted on and approved by the Booster Club members who attended the meeting.
- There will not be a Booster Club meeting in March. The **next Booster Club meeting** will be on **Tuesday, April 4th at 6:30 pm** in the FMHS Library.
